

Metal Panel Maintenance:

- Painted ceiling panels should be wiped down as necessary with a non-rinsing cleaner such as tri-sodium phosphate (T.S.P) or equal.
- Stubborn stains and grease marks can be removed with cleaners such as Formula 409 or Fantastic.
- Use only lint free, soft cloths for wiping down.
- Avoid the use of abrasive cleaners such as Comet or Ajax.
- The Bright and Brushed Finishes should be cleaned with glass cleaners such as Windex, Glass Plus, etc. Wipe in direction of the panel only. Do not use circular motions. Use only soft, lint free cloths.

Genuine Wood Veneer-Wrapped Panel Maintenance:

- Wood veneer-wrapped panels should be cleaned or treated like any other real wood veneer product, e.g., furniture or cabinets.
- Wipe or dust panels down with a damp cloth.
- Avoid any solvent-based cleaning solutions.
- Do not extensively "soak" the parts with any liquid. The finish is a UV cured material, which is very durable, but if water or other liquid is allowed to soak on the edges or ends, it could "wick" under the finish.
